- 2. General PTGO Updates: Ashley Psioda, Chair**
 - a. Kindergarten playdate (Aug. 18 7-8pm): Tony and Amanda met last week with Ashley and Amelia
 - PTGO paid for popsicles last year and had everyone bring their own water bottles
 - There were places for people to fill up water
 - 90 kindergarteners signed up
 - We will use picnic tables outside
 - Ashley and Heather will be at the popsicle playdate
 - Jessica, Leah, Kat out of town
 - Kat will do signage and put out graphic on the Facebook page
 - Amelia: Tony will send out flier
 - b. Open House (Aug. 25)
 - 4-6:30pm QR code table in gym
 - We can split up times at the table
 - c. Teacher lunch for open house
 - We will provide the funds and they put the order in
 - d. Teacher breakfast (Aug. 22) Theme: THRIVE

- Raffles from Tony- we fund
 - Sunrise biscuit: coffee, granola, yogurt, juice
 - Costco in bulk
 - Signup genius for people to donate if we are allowed to provide homemade-Tony said that this is fine.
 - Do people come drop stuff off?
 - Do some catered and then some drop off?
 - Thrive- what do teachers need to thrive, what people need to thrive
 - Decorations and prizes need to be separate from breakfast in budget

- f.** Playground equipment- Spring fundraiser should go to it-already allocated for it: \$10-12k

 - Musical area
 - Replace broken equipment
 - Before or after school starts?
 - School grounds people need to do install to meet safety tests
 - We need to make a decision soon
- g.** Teacher allocations
- \$150 for teachers and then Tony mentioned new teachers or teachers that switch grades get \$75 extra or maybe \$50.
 - 5 new teachers get 150 extra
 - 40k in bank
 - Not all teachers submit teacher allocations
 - Quite a few are switching grades so it might add up
 - 5 in each grade plus specials teachers
 - Budget will be approved in Sept
- h.** Stock the fridge campaign: teachers really appreciated it last year...tackle once school starts?
- Use ptgo funds to stock by August 22 and then use signup genius to get families to donate after that into Sept
- i.** School Spirit Merchandise
- Total Exposure Designs was used last year
 - Do we keep same designs? - yes might help with cost
 - Tie dye was a big seller
 - Teachers liked softer cotton
 - Teachers given free t-shirts provided by PTGO but might have been from Tony's discretionary fund and they were given a voucher
