### River Park Elementary Read-a-Thon Pledge Form

Make a pledge to encourage reading and raise money for River Park Elementary School PTGO! Our Reada-Thon will be based on minutes read per student between October 22-November 4, 2022.

There are two ways to make a pledge:

- 1. You may sponsor a student for a flat amount. For example, if you pledge a flat donation of \$20, no matter how much the student reads you will owe \$20.
- 2. You can pledge an amount for minutes read. For example, if a student reads 300 minutes over the span of the read-a-thon and you sponsored this student for 10 cents a minute, you would owe \$30 ( $0.10 \times 300 = 30$ ). Or at 1 cent a minute, you would owe \$3 ( $0.01 \times 300 = 3$ ). You may also put a limit on any donation, just indicate that on the pledge form.
