Heather King, Treasurers report

- October update- received \$20284. Majority from the readathon. As well as \$100 general donations, \$35 membership dues, and \$136 spirit wear
- The money market account was opened after Grace's recommendation
- Expenses: \$3411- welcome back breakfast, teacher or program specials reimbursement was \$2393, including hispanic heritage night, ice cream social, popsicle playdate. Grant request of \$85 under projects discretionary.
- Closing balance for the end of October to \$55,594
- Final Approval of '25-'26 Budget - Vote
 - Budget reviewed, slight changes made based on lower than expected income from RAT
 - Unanimous approval
- Grant Proposals - Vote
 - Ms. Sensbach and Ms. Price requested \$945 to purchase books to support students as we facilitate higher-order thinking skills for the AIG program. There will be 95 students impacted.
 - Unanimous approval
 - Ms. Carr requested \$466.65 for We Thinkers and Social Flex book series. There will be 200 students impacted in grades K-5 in this school year.
